Need agreement finalized and document to be signed & recorded

Apollo Borough Sanitary Sewer Services - O&A#201318C

KVWPCA flow reduction report - no new information this month (no change)

River Outfalls (No change)

Locations of diversions made to River to date (N. 11th, Parcel A, Standford or N. 4th, N. 3rd)
KVWPCA will add ownership transfer of diversion manholes to acknowledgement
Borough & KVWPCA may want to switch KVWPCA manhole lids (Sanitary to Storm)
KVWPCA & Borough to review Parcel A invert issue
Outflow higher than inflow
May create a future maintenance issue
May want to place concrete in invert prior to property transfer

KVWPCA Manhole at end of S. 2nd and River - Erosion around manhole (No change)

Being caused by groundwater following new sanitary line and coming to ground surface
Could eventually expose pipe creating a greater potential for pipe damage & line freezing
Riprap stone should be placed to repair and prevent future erosion
KVWPCA should cap abandoned line to reduce infiltration

2013 PADEP required reporting data to KVWPCA by Apollo (no change)

O&A to prepare calculations and respond to KVWPCA request for data

KVWPCA Project Update - Brian Johnston

New plant work nearly complete

New flow monitoring

KVWPCA has not yet set a start date for new flow monitoring

The Borough will want to coordinate flow monitoring locations with KVWPCA

KVWPCA may delay flow monitoring to wait for the completion of other separation projects

Vandergrift, East Vandergrift, Kiski Township, Apollo,

Revised rates will be determined based upon flows

Apollo Rates may actually go up since the other communities will have separated

The plant will have excess capacity but costs are divided by only current customers

KVWPCA is not authorized to charge future customers.

Authorization would need to be given by all municipalities (13)

Apollo Borough may want to monitor customer changes in the future and push for recalculations when appropriate

Apollo should attempt to reduce as much flows as possible to keep rate low

Still need to schedule inspections of Apollo house ports in order to help reduce flow

Apollo Borough may have about another year

by 30th

Option 1 would deplete current funds but provide extra \$320.68 a month in revenue
Option 2 would leave current funds in places with only \$1.90 a month in extra revenue
New LGUDA proceedings would be needed to change loan info. With State
