General Services - O&A#201418A

- Liquid Fuel Funding Road Review - O&A#201318A (no change)
  - Hose House alley and Day Way need improved to be added
- Street Opening Ordinance (no change)
- PADOT Paving Project - State Route 56/66 (no change)
  - Handicap Ramp will be done by PADOT as part of work
  - PADOT Notice to Proceed to be issued first of June 2014

Steele Lot Line Revision - O&A#201218B.02

- The mylar (in Apollo Office) still needs signatures and recorded

Apollo Borough Sanitary Sewer Services - O&A#201418C

- KVWPCA flow reduction report - no new information this month (no change)

River Outfalls (No change)

- Locations of diversions made to River to date (N. 11th, Parcel A, Standford or N. 4th, N. 3rd)
- KVWPCA will add ownership transfer of diversion manholes to acknowledgement
  - Borough & KVWPCA may want to switch KVWPCA manhole lids (Sanitary to Storm)
- KVWPCA & Borough to review Parcel A invert issue
  - Outflow higher than inflow
  - May create a future maintenance issue
  - May want to place concrete in invert prior to property transfer

KVWPCA Manhole at end of S. 2nd and River - Erosion around manhole (no change)

- KVWPCA must have a surcharging problem in the line - emailed KVWPCA - no response
- Could eventually expose pipe creating a greater potential for pipe damage & line freezing
- Riprap stone should be placed to repair and prevent future erosion
- KVWPCA should cap abandoned line to reduce infiltration

2014 PADEP required reporting data to KVWPCA by Apollo (no change)

- O&A to prepare calculations and respond to KVWPCA request for data

KVWPCA Project (no change)

- Waiting on project completion & new flow monitoring
- Revised rates will be determined based upon flows
- Apollo should attempt to reduce as much flows as possible to keep rate as low as possible
  - Still need to schedule inspections of Apollo house ports in order to help reduce flow
  - Apollo Borough could pursue CDBG funds to provide low flow toilets for low income residents
    - These toilets would reduce sewage discharges to KVWPCA
    - These toilets would also reduce water useage
    - Overall would provide general and specific cost savings to homeowners

First Street Traffic Light Intersection Project - O&A#201018G

- Apollo Borough Handicap Ramps Improvement Project - County bid docs. - CDBG funds (Complete)
- Apollo Borough Pedestrian Signal Improvement Project - O&A bid docs. - ARLE funds (Complete)
  - The required maintenance bond has been provided
  - Pay Application #2 (final) was paid to Bronder
    - Pedestrian yeild sign installed at NW corner - verified just prior to meeting
  - Apollo Borough should plan to paint new crosswalk lines when weather permits

A complaint had been issued to the Borough about wanting a pedestrian only phase at this intersection. The Borough had requested this but PADOT indicated that it was not warranted due to the low amount of pedestrian traffic. I would encourage the Borough to step up enforcement of traffic yielding to pedestrians and try to station an officer during trail events. Another alternative would be to try and get the trail under the bridge.

Sewer Separation Project - O&A#200918C.14

PADOT Permitting - still waiting on PADOT and Peoples Gas (no change)

Utility Incidents - still waiting to hear back from District Attorney - may want to pursue (no change)

KVWPCA - discharge Elimination (no change)

Currently 642 of 670 structures have connected to the new sanitary sewer system

A total of 28 properties have structures without water service (most vacant)

There are no known Apollo Borough structures contributing sewage to the old sewer line

Discharge Elimination update

Completed - N. 11th St., Parcel A, Standford (N.4th), N.3rd, S. 2nd, S. 3rd, S. 4th,

Grace Street & First Street - Needs diverted - waiting on Kiski. Twp. Project

PENNVEST & PADEP

Waiting on Certificate of Completion - can not be completed until diversions are complete

Kiski Township Project Schedule

Kiski Township new sewer system is operational - restoration remains

Kiski Township residents were notified to connect on 4/11/14

Given 60 days generally for connection the deadline is approximately 6/10/14

However some residents have been given additional time

Water shut off for remaining residents in Kiski Township is unknown

Apollo Borough may be able to complete diversion work and close out project in June

However there seems to be no certainty of when all residents will be connected
