KVWPCA flow reduction report

No significant reduction observed as of yet

In a dry season when the results of the separation would not show

River Outfalls

Locations of diversions (N. 11th, Parcel A, Standford or N. 4th, N. 3rd, Grace, High Rise)

KVWPCA will add ownership transfer of diversion manholes to acknowledgement

Acknowledgement not changed - submitted to solicitor for review

KVWPCA not switching manhole covers at this time (Sanitary to Storm)

Apollo Borough has KVWPCA permission to switch if so desired

KVWPCA & Borough to review Parcel A invert issue

Outflow higher than inflow

May create a future maintenance issue

May want to place concrete in invert prior to property transfer

KVWPCA Manhole at end of S. 2nd and River - Erosion around manhole

KVWPCA indicated that they will raise this manhole in the next few weeks

KVWPCA Project

Project completion

New sewage treatment process to begin by first of October

In plant pump station replacment to be done by 2/2016

Waiting on project completion & new flow monitoring

Revised rates will be determined based upon flows

Apollo should attempt to reduce as much flows as possible to keep rate as low as possible

Still need to schedule inspections of Apollo house ports in order to help reduce flow

Apollo Borough could pursue CDBG funds to provide low flow toilets for low income residents

These toilets would reduce sewage discharges to KVWPCA

These toilets would also reduce water useage

Overall would provide general and specific cost savings to homeowners

2015 PADEP required reporting data to KVWPCA by Apollo (no change)

O&A to prepare calculations and respond to KVWPCA request for data

Sewer Separation Project - O&A#200918C 14

Currently 611 of 634 structures have connected to the new sanitary sewer system

A total of 23 properties have structures without water service (most vacant)

PENNVEST & PADEP

Released remaining PENNVEST funds - \$149,310

Need to resubmit Buy American Certificate to PENNVEST

PADOT Permitting - still waiting on PADOT and Peoples Gas (no change)

Utility Incidents - still waiting to hear back from District Attorney - may want to pursue (no change)

O&A would like to close out project since items are complete or not changed for some time

Armstrong County Aid - O&A#201518D.01 - \$8,100

West Penn Power street light installation - to be designed next week with installation to follow  
line painting completed earlier this week

Funds can not be requested until entire project is complete & verified - waiting on light pole
